This opportunity is truly a great time and a great way to support a huge community event; not to mention a fantastic fundraiser for your organization. Now, here is how it works. You as a non-profit organization would be apart our Parking Committee and handle the parking of thousands of vehicles during the Battle Creek Field of Flight. By doing so, your organization will share in a percentage of the revenue collected (from the parking fee) during the entire event and achieve \$\$\$\$\$\$! Basically, if your group chooses "Option A" you will more than likely achieve over \$6,000 (weather permitting)! This is truly a lot easier than selling candy bars and it is a great deal of fun to do it as an organization, a club, a church, school sports, etc.

I can honestly tell you that the weather will play an important part! When the weather cooperates, we excel in all areas! When the weather does not, revenues will be down for all involved. For the most part, we have been blessed with pretty good weather and I anticipate 2026 will not be a disappointment!

Now, to accomplish our goal, we are looking for five (5) to six (6) groups or organizations to commit to this opportunity. In order to achieve the top dollar bracket, you really want to be working every day and all day, which is "Option A". However, the following is your guide or choices for participation.

Option A: Provide 8 individuals to work every day and all shifts.

Option B: Provide 8 Individuals to work every day for two (2) shifts.

Option C: Provide 8 Individuals to work three (3) days (July 2, 3, 4) for the first two shifts.

Please understand priority will be given to those groups that can commit to "Option A" and who participated with the 2025 Field of Flight. However, don't hesitate to contact the Field of Flight Office to discuss any thoughts you might have.

Once you have decided to be a part of this great opportunity, we need you to complete the "Commitment Form" and email it to me (barb@bcballoons.com), fax it 269-962-8687 or send it via mail as soon as possible to secure a place or to be considered. You will receive confirmation for participation and we will confirm a meeting date and time for all accepted groups. We hope to have all groups in position to earn \$\$\$\$\$\$ by May 1, 2026. This will give each group time to get organized.

Once you receive official confirmation, we do suggest that you begin rounding up your volunteers. We also suggest that you find five (5) key people to help you organize and recruit volunteers. Each key person would handle rounding up the volunteers for one (1) of the days each....encourage family and friends to help! Great way for the kids to earn their National Honor Society Hours.

TENTATIVE PARKING SCHEDULE

PLEASE NOTE: These totals are based on a minimum of four (3) Groups providing 8 PEOPLE to work each day, all day; in our Main Parking Lot off Helmer Road; one (1) Group providing 8 PEOPLE to work each day, all day; South Airport Road BLUFISH Lot. Please remember you can schedule your volunteers with a different “shift” breakdown. This is just our suggested “shifts” which are mostly five (5) hour blocks. Just understand that the maximum you will get credit for is 8 People per day (unless another group needs more volunteers to fill their obligated amount). WE need volunteers to arrive at least 45 Minutes prior to our daily opening schedule (**this is reflected in the Shift Times**)! Volunteers will also have “free” access to the Field of Flight Event Grounds and activities once you have completed your shift(s).

2026 BATTLE CREEK FIELD OF FLIGHT AIR SHOW AND BALLOON FESTIVAL INFORMATION TO ASSIST PARKING

Helmer Road Parking – South and North Ends

Please plan to arrive on time for your shift. We need everyone there 45 minutes before the start of the Shift. The best route for you to take for all shifts will be to use Territorial Road into Helmer Road. You will turn right (North) on Helmer Road. You will enter through Gate 16 and be directed to your team from there. Make sure that everyone has their proper parking pass as this will let Battle Creek Police Department know where to direct you. This route will also keep you out of the Spectator Traffic.

The Parking Trailer is air conditioned and any volunteer is welcome to go sit in there to cool down. This is also where you will get your radios each morning. You will have a canopy tent to keep your personal coolers and personal belongings. Please plan to bring a few bag chairs. There will be a wooden box, this will have the parking vests, flashlights and flags for directing the traffic. Depending on which end of the field you are at will determine which canopy tent you can claim as yours for the day/Event. You can bring coolers, snacks, food, etc. Just no grilling! We will have a large jug of water for you daily along with a few cases of water. Please plan to bring a water Bottle. If you need ice or water, we will provide that and you will be given instructions prior to the event who your POC is.

There will be breakdown of the various Flag Colors we have throughout the grounds(WILL SEND THAT LIST LATER AS WE ARE CHANGING UP SOME OF THE COLORS WITH NEW FLAGS). Please be sure to brief all your workers as to what these colors stand for! Most important: Blue is Handicapped Up along the Fence line; some of the Blue can be a mixture of Handicapped and regular cars. Yellow and White Checkered are the Walk Shoots to get to the Admission Gate. Motorcycles can park (on the taxiway 1331) which is in the middle of the Main Parking Lot. ALL motorcycles entering off Helmer Road are to be directed to the Black and White Checkered Flags.

BREAKDOWN OF PARKING PASSES – Back Side of all passes have a QR Code that brings up our Schedule of Events.

Daily Parking Passes will be dated for each day (Wednesday with a Big 1, etc). They are good only for the day indicated on the pass. **Except PICK A DAY, that is good for any day. You remove the Pick A Day Pass and give them the perspective day pass. Those collecting money, please keep this pass with your collection money as this does count towards our numbers.**

Gate #6 and VIP Passes should be directed to Gate #6 at the end of South Airport Road. Some of these passes have the number stamped on them meaning they are only good on that particular day; some will have an "A" which means they are good every day of the event! Should someone pull in with that Pass off Helmer Road, they can park in the general lot or choose to turn around and follow the directions they were given for South Airport Road; off Columbia Avenue.

Airport User Passes and Duncan Aviation Passes are only permitted in their perspective businesses and are NOT Permitted to park for free in our Parking Lots.

RV's are not permitted in the General Parking areas. The RV Parking Pass for the RV and Vehicles are to park in the RV Lot regardless if staying overnight or just for the day. **NO RV's in General Parking.**

Parking Passes and Daily Admission are good for the entire day! People can come and go as they please but we never guarantee them a particular spot on return! Please note: Children 3 ft and under are free every day at our Admission Gates.

INFO FOR TEAM LEADS

- *Main Lot (Off Helmer Road) will direct their volunteers to drive their vehicles up to the closest parking rows to help start the actual rows. But first let the Collection Committee know which group you are with.
- *For collections at the Main Lot, a POC will have the start-up money in Aprons each morning.
- *For BluFish Lot, a POC will be there to bring you your start up aprons, money and Daily Parking Passes.
- *When putting your schedules together, the first group in the morning needs to arrive 45 Minutes prior to the Gates and Parking Open which is on our Overall Event Schedule and or Event Brochure. So, if Parking and Gates open at 9:00 am then workers must be in place by 8:15 am.
- *Each group must give us a daily record of those that came to work parking on a daily basis and shift basis.
- *Each group must give us the POC's for the First Shift with Cell Phone Numbers.
- *Collect \$5.00 from each vehicle including motorcycles. Motorcycles will park on the Taxiway by the "Black and White Checkered Flags". BluFish lot please collect the \$5.00, give them a parking pass and send them to Gate #6. Security will direct them to the proper place. Please collect \$5.00 before sending them to that location. Bicycles will also pay \$5.00 and park just beyond the motorcycles. We will advance sales for parking and scanners will be provided to the Collections Team.
- *All Handicapped Vehicles will be directed to the BLUE Flags in the Lots. Be sure to Radio ahead to your group to let them know type of vehicle heading to the Handicapped Parking. MUST HAVE HANDICAPPED STICKER or License Plate.
- *Please direct RV's to the RV Lot off Helmer Road and do not collect from them. Again, they do not park in our General Lots.
- *Understand that the Parking Lot off Helmer Road is considered the Main Lot or Helmer Road Lots; and Parking Lot off S. Airport Road is BLUFISH Lot.
- *Each group will be given Committee Badges to give your volunteers to be able to go on the event grounds. Keep those locked up in your Wooden Box. Make sure you collect them back each day! You will also be given PICK A DAY Wristbands for your workers to go enjoy the event!
- *Bring pad lock to lock the Box and make sure your group Team Leads know the combination to access supplies and for locking personal belongings in.
- *Parking Passes with the GATE #6 on them or VIP should be sent directly to Gate #6 off South Airport Road and pass BLUFish Lot. If you have any questions, please call on the radio or simply send them to Gate #6 and our On Field Security Team will handle it.
- *Best will be to have 4 people Collecting between the Road and in the Parking Lot. Space the people 100 ft. apart. The first person will send the first two to three cars to the furthest collector, the next person, etc. This is for Helmer Road lots. For BLUFISH lot, the first Canopy in the Road is for directing them in to the BLUFish Lot. This canopy will be in the Grass across from Duncan Aviation. All individuals with a GATE #6, VIP or Airport User Pass will just continue down S Airport Road. Collection will be inside the lot with at least 4 people collecting and being spaced out at least 100 ft. You will have your collectors down the Side of the lot so we can keep the traffic moving and not blocking up Columbia Avenue.
- *Collectors in the main lot, will call their POC should you need change and for money pick up. Please encourage people to give you "five dollars" verses large bills. Those in the BLUFISH lot will also radio the POC for money pick up change and more parking passes.
- *Collectors will give parking passes to the spectators after they have paid; they will then send them to the Flag Volunteers for exact parking instructions.
- *Remind people to write down on their parking pass what sponsor sign they are parked closest to or the Main Lot/BluFish Lot.
- *We will have a Water Person bringing water around to all workers including BluFish Lot. Please keep your small water bottle to refill. Be sure to take breaks and eat! Great food Vendors on the Grounds. Please be sure to put a lock on your box and pass the key or combination to your team members.

*We have Free Shuttle Service. Call for Shuttle on the radio and give them location for pick up. We can move 5 people per run per Shuttle.

*Balloonists will have a special decal on the side of their chase commanders and a balloon basket! They park for free and have been instructed to park off South Airport Road in Gate 6.

*All Entertainers have been instructed to use South Airport Road; they have been sent the necessary Passes. However, if they have extra cars with them and no passes, please send them to Gate #6 and Security will handle the issue.

*No Tents or Chairs are allowed to set up in the Parking Lots!

*No Fireworks, No pets!!

*Wear Comfortable Shoes.....Flip Flops are not good.

*Bring Sunscreen.

-Have them start your lines for the parking of the vehicles by parking their cars to form the lines.

*Golf Cart – Some Team Leads will have access to a cart to shuttle workers.

*Bring a cooler with food if you so desire and keep it under your canopy.

*Please make sure that you do not have personal chatter on the radios. This is just to keep everyone on the same page.

*Each Group will get 12 Badges that will allow Free Admission into the Event Grounds. So, after someone has worked a shift and they want to go in to get a bite to eat, have them wear the badge in. Make sure they return the Badge once they return or are leaving. You will also get PICK A DAY Wristbands to give to your workers as a perk which allows free admission. See VOLUNTEER PERKS for how they achieve free admission passes based on number of hours worked. You can fill out a sheet for those that earned them and we can compile individual packets.

* Volunteers working the Main Lot, please use Territorial Road to access the Main Lot. You will have a Special Parking Pass. POC's will need to give each person working this Parking Pass in order for them to have easy access. Should they forget their pass, please let BC Police know at Territorial and Helmer Road that you are working Parking. Regardless if you are working the South End or the North End, you will enter in through Gate 16.

*Please Note: July 1 will be a training day and all Team Leads need to be present to learn the system.

This information is just to give you a broad idea as to what you will be doing. More information will be given to you once we have all teams confirmed.

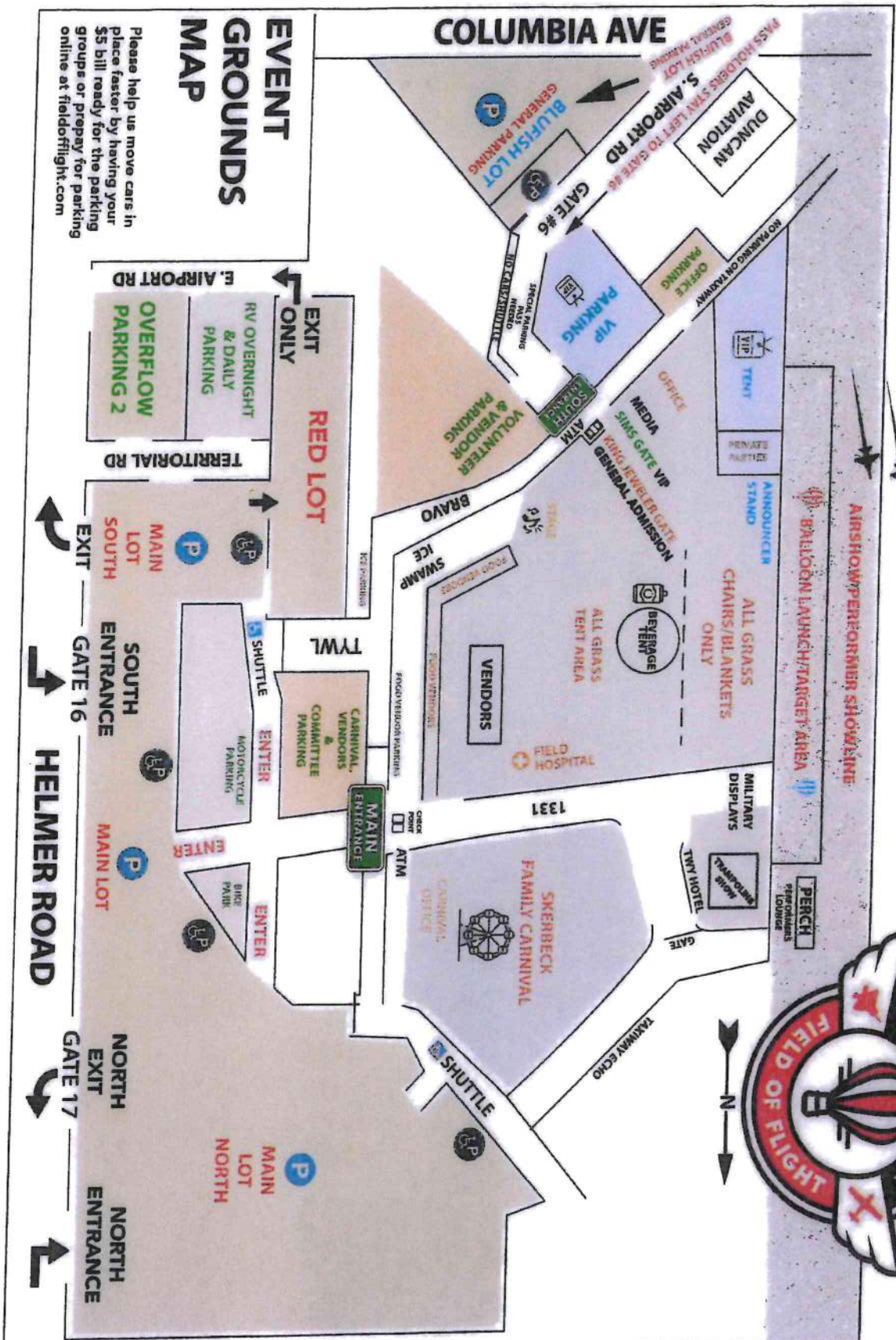
